The program includes an exclusive opportunity to attend Southwest Michigan First's Catalyst University in January 2023. Participants will also take the Gallup CliftonStrengths assessment and use that as a development tool throughout the program.

In addition, participants will gain access to unique, hands-on experiences with community-based organizations. We bring together dynamic professionals, cutting-edge faculty and a rigorous curriculum to accelerate leadership development and create a truly transformational learning experience.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

The calendar for **LEADERSHIP KALAMAZOO** 2023 is like none other. Curated community experiences will allow the group to elevate their leadership, build their network and deepen their roots in the social fabric of our region. The program consists of **Learning Sessions** and **Community Tours**.

- **Learning Sessions** | These sessions include the full group, diving into leadership topics and best practices together. They are interactive, engaging and include a lineup of guest experts.
- **Community Tours** | These sessions take the group out into the community for hands-on learning and engagement around topics such as economic development, health, education and public safety.
